

****IMPORTANT****

To protect the health and safety of children attending school, the state has strict requirements for completion of physical, dental and eye examination forms. In order for your child to attend school, we must have these completed forms on file at Westchester Primary School. Children without completed physical forms will be excluded from school as of **August 29, 2011**, as required by District 92 ½ Board Policy.

The physical form must be completed for all new students to WPS by a doctor and includes the following:

- **documentation of lead screening with testing when indicated**
- **all required immunizations**
- **a district-required TB test**
- **diabetes screening**



The parent or guardian must also complete and sign the **Health History** portion at the top of the back page of the physical form in order to be considered complete.

The **dental form** must be completed by **August 29th** or by May 15th before the start of first grade.

An **eye examination** must be completed by an optometrist or doctor who provides complete eye examinations. This form must be received by the school by **August 29th**.

We encourage you to schedule your child's physical, dental and eye examination appointments as early as possible. Often, there are fewer available doctors' appointments as it gets closer to the beginning of school.

The Cook County Department of Public Health also provides immunizations and other clinical services (by appointment only) to Westchester residents at their district office:
