- III.B. <u>APPROVAL OF THE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES OF FEBRURY 6, 2017</u>: A motion was made by Mrs. Wilhight, seconded by Mr. Gress, that the minutes of the February 6, 2017 Buildings and Grounds Committee meeting be approved as written. When the question was called, the vote was taken with the following results: 3 Ayes; 0 Nays; 2 Absent. The Chairman Pro-Tem declared the motion carried.

IV. DISCUSSION ITEMS WITHOUT ACTION:

- A. Summer 2017 Capital Projects Discussion
 - Mr. Gress presented to the committees the final architectural plans from Legat Architects for the mantraps in each of the three school buildings. Mr. Gress informed the committees that he presented the plans to the building principals, secretaries and maintenance teams for their feedback.
 - 2. Mr. Gress presented a sample of a noise control panel that Legat is proposing to be installed on the ceiling of the WMS gymnasium. The committees requested that Mr. Gress have Legat price out this option as well as the original plan of installing noise control panels on the walls.
 - 3. Mr. Gress shared the anticipated timeline for the bid process.
 - 4. Mr. Gress informed the committees that a number of the new light fixtures in the WMS gymnasium have had to be replaced. Currently they are under warranty and the contractor has been responsive to fix them. The committees asked Mr. Gress to check with both Legat and the contractor about the repair/replacement costs after the warranty expires.
- B. Review of Financial Reports for February 2017:
 - 1. Revenue Received to Date: Year-to-date revenue received should be at least at 66% of budget to be on track with the budget. Revenue has started to arrive from the March 1 Cook County property tax installment and should continue for the next two months.
 - 2. Mr. Gress informed the committees that it was discovered that invoices related to eRate reimbursements were not filed for 2015-2016, but he was able to submit them just in time before the cut-off date. The District will be getting approximately \$27,000 from eRate.
 - 3. Expenditure Listing: Several line items on this report were questioned and discussed for clarification.
 - 4. Encumbrance listing: Several line items on this report were questioned and discussed for clarification.
 - 5. New Grant Opportunities/Grants Received: The committees were given a report showing the Title grants awarded for 2016-2017 (\$262,763) and expensed through February 28, 2017 (\$107,593).
