- V.A. <u>APPROVE THE BILLS, CLAIMS AND PAYROLLS AS PRESENTED</u>: Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, a motion was made by Mrs. Sanchez, seconded by Mrs. Wesolowski, that the bills and claims in the amount of \$743,375.52 and payrolls in the amount of \$898,641.98 be approved and authorized for payment. - V.C. <u>AUTHORIZE THE APPROVAL OF AN ENERGY CONTRACT FOR GAS</u>: Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, a motion was made by Mrs. Douglas-Pieniazek, seconded by Mr. Voegtle, to authorize the approval of an energy contract for gas. When the question was called, the Roll Call Vote was taken with the following results: 7 members voting Aye, Boyd, Douglas-Pieniazek, Ortiz, Sanchez, Quiroz, Wesolowski, Voegtle; 0 Nays; 0 Absent. The President declared the motion carried.
- VI.A. <u>ESTIMATED TAX LEVY DISCUSSION</u>: Mr. Gress presented the estimated tax levy. The tax cap law limits tax extensions by 5% or CPI, whichever is less. Since our levy is less than a 5% increase, we are not subject to the Truth-In-Taxation Act requirements. However, the District intends to follow the same basic steps as outlined in the Truth-In-Taxation Act, approving the estimated tax levy at the November 11, 2021 Board meeting and conducting a public hearing and adopting the 2021 tax levy at the December 9, 2021 Board meeting.
- VI.B. <u>WMS ROOFING PROJECT CONSIDERATION</u>: Mr. Gress presented information regarding next summer's anticipated capital project replacing/restoring sections of the WMS roof. The District recently applied for a \$50,000 School Maintenance Grant which, if received, would be used to fund a portion of the project.
- VI.C. <u>IASB RESOLUTIONS REVIEW</u>: The Board discussed the new resolutions, amended existing resolution, reaffirmation of existing positions, new belief statement, and amended belief statement being presented at the annual IASB Delegate Assembly and determined its recommendation to guide Mrs. Boyd, the District's representative, in voting.
- VI.D. <u>UPDATE ON BOARD MEETING RECORDINGS</u>: Mr. Banbor presented a proposed process to record Board meetings and make the meetings available for the public to view via YouTube following the meeting. A trial run will be done at an upcoming meeting.
