- VI.A. <u>WMS SCHEDULE DISCUSSION</u>: Mr. Leban shared updates with the proposed FY 2022 WMS schedule and presented concerns and opportunities regarding the scheduling of Arts and Tech classes. The Board asked to review FY 2022 data mid-year to prepare for FY 2023.
- VI.B. <u>SUMMER PROJECTS DISCUSSION (MASONRY REPAIRS, PROJECTORS AT WPS, AND ADDITIONAL ACCESS POINTS)</u>: Mr. Gress and Mr. Banbor presented three projects for completion this summer: masonry repairs at the District Office; installing additional access points throughout the District; and upgrading projectors and boards (whiteboards and corkboards) at WPS.

- VI.C. <u>ENERGY CONTRACT DISCUSSION (GAS)</u>: Mr. Gress noted that our current natural gas contract with Vanguard Energy Services ends on June 30 and he will be requesting that the Board enters into a new multi-year contract prior to that date.
- VI.D. <u>CHROMEBOOK SALE DISCUSSION</u>: Mr. Banbor and Mr. Gress presented a plan to sell approximately 700 Chromebooks for which Google support is ending.
- VI.E. <u>TIF DISCUSSION</u>: Mr. Gress updated the Board regarding the Cermak Road TIF District Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village.
