

## Q33 I am satisfied with the District's level of involvement in the larger Westchester community.





## Q35 I am satisfied with the accessibility to address the Board of Education at Board meetings.



After a review of the Satisfaction Survey results in the area of Community Relations, it became evident that the school district could garner greater support through an intentional and deliberate effort to reach a larger audience in the community. The Community Relations subcommittee of the District's Strategic Planning Committee brainstormed methods of reaching that larger audience using a variety of methods.

**Priority Target:** Board Members and Administrative Team deliberate and intentional accessibility to the parents and community

Although Satisfaction Survey results suggest that this target is not of major concern, deliberate and intentional accessibility will facilitate communication and good will among all stakeholder groups thereby creating positive relations throughout the community. As Board members are elected officials in the community and district and school administrators are entrusted with the community's greatest assets, the children, it was determined that strategies be followed to ensure accessibility and grow a partnership with students' parents and the larger Westchester community.

Following the same theme of communicating and forging relationships with the greater Westchester community, senior citizens were identified by the subcommittee as a resource that is underutilized in the schools. Westchester enjoys a large percentage of retired professionals who could offer much experience and insight to the District's students.
